Thursday, March 2nd: Cartel Land (USA, 2015, 100 min.)

A full immersion into the hair-raising world of Mexican drug traffickers, people smugglers, citizen vigilantes and... quiet heroes. *You're against Trump's wall along the Mexican/U.S. border? Of course! But first watch this documentary. Then oppose the wall.*



Thursday, March 16th: Brainwashing of My Dad (USA, 2016, 90 min.) Trump's rhetoric seems outrageous? Not to the millions who listen to right-wing talk radio, skillfully designed to instill bigotry. The film shows how it grew under Nixon and then Reagan and its disruptive effects in one typical family.



Thursday, March 30th: Occupation of the American Mind: Israel's Public Relations War in the United States (USA, 2016, 85 min.)

How Israel has managed to win the battle for the hearts, minds, and tax dollars of American citizens, despite worldwide condemnation of its occupation of Palestine.



Thursday, April 13th: The Kill Team (USA, 2014, 79 min.)

The major cause of death among U.S. troops in Afghanistan is suicide. This film examines the immense psychological pressure troops there face, how war crimes become a game and how trying to denounce them makes a soldier... the enemy.



Thursday, April 27th: We Come as Friends (France/Austria, 2014, 110 min.) A surreal, moving, infuriating, breathtaking portrait of South Sudan, in the throes of a post-colonialism that is "post" in name only. More than a political pamphlet, the film is a mosaic of images that make you feel what people there feel.
