Today Saturday, October 27, for the first time ever mass demonstrations are taking place in 11 cities throughout the U.S. calling for the immediate withdrawal of troops from Iraq and no military action against Iran. We are here today in Rome to support these demonstrations in the U.S., but more importantly to call attention to more than 1,000,000¹ civilian deaths, the 2,200,000² internally displaced and the 2,200,000³ Iraqis who have fled their country. A nation where the saying "today is better than tomorrow" has become tragically popular.
